 <p>Glass Bottles & Jars (NO other types of glass)</p>	 <p>Newspaper, Mixed Paper & Paperboard (Cereal boxes)</p>	 <p>Plastic Bottles (Plastic containers #1-5, 7) (NO #6)</p>

 <p>X No plastic bags, wrap, packaging or film</p>	 <p>X No paper towels, plates, cups, tissue or wax paper</p>	 <p>X No Styrofoam, foam containers or packaging</p>
<p>X No Wood or tree waste</p>	<p>X No Plastic picnicware (plates, cups, utensils, tablecloths)</p>	<p>X No Dirty, wet or greasy food-contaminated items</p>
<p>X No Scrap Metal</p>	<p>X No Plastic toys of any kind</p>	<p>If you have doubt throw it out!</p>
